Dr. Hoffman has done post-doctoral study in the following modalities:

- **Regenerative Injection Therapy (Prolotherapy); Naturopathic Academy of Therapeutic Injection.** Injection therapy for chronic, unresponsive muscle & joint pain.
- **Cosmetic Mesotherapy; Naturopathic Academy of Therapeutic Injection.** Injection treatment for fat & cellulite reduction; alternative to liposuction.

- **Mesotherapy; Naturopathic Academy of Therapeutic Injection.** Traditional mesotherapy is an injection therapy used for the treatment of acute & chronic sports injuries.
- **Scar Therapy; Naturopathic Academy of Therapeutic Injection.** Injection therapy used to reduce the appearance of surgical scars & scars due to trauma.
- **Myofascial trigger point; Naturopathic Academy of Therapeutic Injection.** Anesthetic is injected directly into areas of the body where pain is present
- **Neural therapy; Naturopathic Academy of Therapeutic Injection.** Homeopathic and anesthetics are used to help relieve pain
- **Regional anesthesia; Naturopathic Academy of Therapeutic Injection.** Nerve blocks to block painful areas
