

# Who is Dr. Greg Uchacz ?

## *What you may not know about your Chiropractor!*

Dr. Uchacz achieved his Doctor of Chiropractic (D.C.) degree in 1992 from Palmer College of Chiropractic West in San Jose, California, and has since maintained a family and sport chiropractic practice in Calgary Alberta. During his first four years of practice he continued his schooling, completing a four-year specialty in Sports Chiropractic. As a result, he was awarded Fellowship status with the College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences of Canada (CCSS(C)) and is considered a Sports Specialist in his field. Dr. Uchacz is one of only a few Chiropractors with such a distinction in Alberta and one of approximately 85 in Canada. Dr. Uchacz is also a Certified Strength and Conditioning Specialist through the North American Strength and Conditioning Association.

In addition to his practice, Dr, Uchacz has been actively involved in several professional activities;

- **Olympic Health Care Team Member; 2002 & 2006 Winter Olympics**  
Dr. Uchacz was the chiropractor for Canada's athletes at the 2002 Winter Olympics Games in Salt Lake City, Utah and the 2006 Winter Olympic Games in Torino, Italy.
- **National Team Chiropractor; Bobsleigh Canada Skeleton 2000 - 2006.** Dr. Uchacz was the official Team Chiropractor for the Canadian Bobsleigh and Skeleton Teams. He attended both the 2002 and 2006 Winter Olympic Games as a Canadian Health Care Team professional.
- **National Team Chiropractor; Athletics Canada 1998 – 2003.** Dr. Uchacz was the official Team Chiropractor for the Canadian Track and Field (Athletics) Team. In 2000 he attended the Canadian Junior National Championships in Montreal, Canada's Pre-Olympic Meet in Flagstaff, Arizona, and the Olympic Trials in Victoria, British Columbia. He was the official Canadian Team chiropractor for the 1999 World University Games in Mallorca, Spain, the 2001 World Athletic Championships in Edmonton, Alberta and the 2003 Pan American Games in the Dominican Republic.
- **President; Board of Directors of the College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences of Canada 2002 – Present** Dr. Uchacz presides over this Board of Directors that exists as the national governing body of Sports Chiropractic in Canada. He is currently in his third term as President.

- **2<sup>nd</sup> Vice-President; Board of Directors of the College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences of Canada 1998 – 2002**
- **Chairman; Fellowship Committee of the College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences of Canada 2000 – 2003** The position involved chairing a committee that designed and administered an exiting examination for candidates wishing to attain Sports Fellowship Status in Canada.
- **Chairman; Academic Coordinating Committee of the College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences of Canada 1998 – 2000** The position involved chairing a committee that designed the curriculum and arranged the lecturers for the Sports Sciences specialty academic program.
- **Alberta Provincial Representative; to the College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences of Canada 1996 – 1999** Dr. Uchacz acted as liaison between the College of Chiropractors of Alberta and the College of Chiropractic Sports Sciences of Canada. He coordinated Chiropractic involvement in sport for Alberta and provided an Alberta perspective to the CCSS(C).
- **Medical Advisory Board Member; Medical Scope Monthly: Canada's Clinical Medicine Journal 1997 – 1999** Dr. Uchacz was a medical advisory board member for a nationally distributed clinical medicine journal.
- **Editorial Advisory Board; Canadian Chiropractor: 2002 – Present.**
- **Physical Examinations Coordinator; Alberta Board of Chiropractic Examiners 1995 – 1998** Dr. Uchacz worked with the Psychometrics department of the University of Calgary in designing and establishing one of four sections of the Alberta Clinical Competency Examination. Once the examination was designed, Dr. Uchacz trained 15 Chiropractor to serve as examiners for his section. This examination was taken by all Chiropractors wishing to gain licensure in Alberta.
- **Professional and Amateur Sporting Events; Attended over 100 International competitions as a Primary Health Care Provider for a variety of sports**
- **Research; Actively involved in research regarding chiropractic specialties admission criteria and in the effect of chiropractic intervention in sports performance enhancement.**
